Pledge led and prayer given by Chairman Randy Bishop. Treasurer report Gregg Valerio. Motion to accept Carla Bart 2nd Mike Lockman Approved.

Secretary report Cherie Hogan. Three corrections noted. Motion to accept Rob Bargy, 2nd Mike. All approved.
